TAKE YOUR FIRST STEPS:

Get an EORI-number

Make sure you have an Economic Operator Registration and Identification number. This is required for customs clearance. It's free to apply for your number and currently only takes a few days to be issued.

SHIPPING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ALL SHIPMENTS

From 1 January 2021, we will require a commercial invoice and packing slip with every shipment to take care of the export or import declaration with customs.

Make sure that all information is mentioned on the documents and can be sent to De Riike in time to avoid any delays at the border.

You will need commodity codes for all your goods. This allows you to apply the correct rate of duty, keeps your business compliant with HMRC and allows us to correctly declare your shipments.
